

Transparency in Energy Production Act of 2021

Section-by-Section

Sec. 1 establishes the Act as the Transparency in Energy Production Act of 2021

Sec. 2 requires any entity seeking or holding a lease to develop or produce energy on public lands to report the amount, type, and source of energy.

Sec. 3 mandates that the information reported under section 2 be made available to the public on the internet.

Sec. 4 requires the agency of jurisdiction to submit a report to Congress within 2 years of enactment and every 2 thereafter that includes, with respect to energy development operations on public lands,

- (1) the annual and 2-year totals of greenhouse gas emissions, air quality, water management, biodiversity impacts, production, and number of sites;
- (2) the changes in the information in paragraph (1);
- (3) the projected future changes for 5, 10, and 25 years; and
- (4) for renewable energy operations, an estimate of the greenhouse gas emissions that would result from production of the same amount of energy using fossil fuels and water management, including water use, biodiversity impacts, production, number of sites, and acres including associated transmission lines.
